

Selecting a Blog Site for your 4-H Record



What is a Blog?

Short for *Web log*, a blog is a Web page that serves as a publicly accessible personal journal for an individual. Typically updated frequently, blogs often reflect the experience of the author.

Factors to Consider in Your Decision Making:

- Advertisements Are there advertisements that could distract from message?
- Purpose Who is the site owner and what is their purpose for offering blog services?
- Cost What is the cost of use and/or membership?
- Features Are there features appropriate for author's needs and interests?
- Ease of Use Will the site be easy to use based on author's knowledge and skill level?
- Privacy Settings & Terms of Service What are they and are they appropriate for use?
- Access Who can see the blog? Is it public, private or controlled access?
- Adult Monitoring How will the blog be monitored by adults for safety?

Google Blogger www.blogger.com	Free, powered by Google if you have other Google accounts	Advertisements, Outside access to public blogs
LiveJournal <u>www.livejournal.com</u>	Free, used by millions across the nation, many design features	Advertisements and online shopping available, Outside access to public blogs
WordPress <u>www.wordpress.com</u>	Free, blog site used by UW-Extension, lots of great features and easy to use, advanced privacy settings, can be developed into website	Advertisements
Tumblr <u>www.tumblr.com</u>	Free, capability to upload by mobile device and to social media (Twitter and Facebook)	Advertisements, best used in microblogging reblogging formats
Squidoo <u>www.squidoo.com</u>	Free, themes are kid-friendly and creatively, capability to upload by mobile device and to social media (Twitter and Facebook)	Advertisements, has its own squidoo "language"
Kidblog <u>www.kidblog.org</u>	Free, no advertising, built for use with schools, Private by default but semi-public users allowed	Meant for teachers to use with classrooms of students and users must be managed by moderator
Edublog <u>www.edublog.org</u>	Free, no advertising, built for use with students and teachers, no adult contact or outside blogs allowed	Meant for teachers to use with classrooms of students and users must be managed by moderator
