The Wisconsin Pork Association Youth Committee is offering Youth Pig Project scholarships. These scholarships are designed to assist 4-H and FFA members in establishing swine projects that can lead to development of life skills and career opportunities in the Wisconsin pork industry.

4-H and FFA youth are eligible to apply for a \$50.00 scholarship used to offset costs associated with their 2019 pig project. At least twenty \$50.00 scholarships will be awarded. Age divisions, as of January 1, 2019 are as follows: Ages 9-12, 13-15, and 16-19.
