Youth will gain critical thinking and problem solving skills by engaging in hands-on experiential learning experiences.

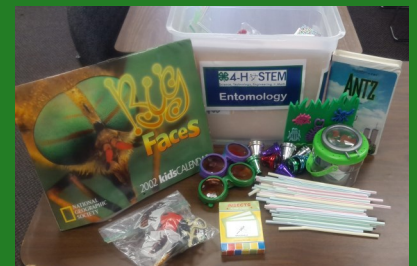
Learning Science Through Inquiry:
